







Ponce City Market to reshape City Hall East

ATLANTA -- Developers behind the transformation of the massive City Hall East building have created an initial concept that would call the project Ponce City Market and they believe it can echo the success of their Chelsea Market in Manhattan.

Jamestown and its subsidiary Green Street Properties are in final stages of closing on the 2 million-square-foot City Hall East building on Ponce de Leon Avenue.

The building, a relic of early 20th century Atlanta finished in 1929, is the former home of Sears Roebuck & Co.

The developers unveiled the initial concept for Ponce City Market at May's International Council of Shopping Centers event in Las Vegas.

Early plans call for about 236,500 square feet of retail and 21,250 square feet for restaurants, including a food hall designed to become
